Venice High School Alumni Association Hall of Fame

Criteria

- 1. Nominees must have attended or worked at Venice High School for a reasonable period of time.
- 2. They must have done significant service or made long-term contributions, made a positive impact on their local community and exemplify role model character.
- 3. While some have served local programs over a long and distinguished career, their accomplishments must have been worthy of recognition to be considered.

Categories

- 1. Athletics Must be recognized for outstanding contributions such as all state, all city, holding a significant record in a sport, winning a state championship, all American, Hall of Fame, etc.
- 2. Entertainment (Actors, Technicians) must have made a considerable contribution or have been given a recognizable award such as Grammy, Oscar, Emmy, Tony, etc.
- 3. Communication (Media, Journalism) must have made a considerable contribution or won a recognizable award in their field such as Pulitzer, Peabody, etc.
- 4. Public Service (Government, Political) must have made a considerable contribution such as City Attorney, State Supreme Court, Federal Judge, Mayor, County Supervisor, Senator, etc.
- 5. Exemplary Professional Recognized and distinguished in a given field such as Military, Medicine, Education, etc.

Guidelines

It is the expectation that inductees are at the ceremony. If they are unable to attend, we ask that a representative be present. Occasional exceptions are considered.

Recipients of the Hall of Fame award will be honored and inducted each year as part of the homecoming celebrations, or other special ceremonies or events, to be determined by the committee.
